

How to use WNC MMA meetings as Continuing Ed Credit

In order to verify credit hours:

1. Keep a copy of agenda from meeting you attend.
2. You will have to attest that what you are reporting is true when you log hours on the MGMA website.
3. You can log hours you've received previously. And not just in 2019. The 50 hours of CE requirement is over a span of 3 years. So, if your certification cycle started in 2017, they can count hours from then through 2020. If anyone is unsure what years their cycle runs, send Michelle Wallace Torak an email and she can find out for you.
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Per Michelle: Meeting topics qualify as “face-to-face” continuing education credits. For an activity to meet the criteria for ACMPE continuing education credit hours, it must:

- Be relevant to the Body of Knowledge for Medical Practice Management
- Be delivered in a structured learning environment
- Have an element of interactivity

The WNCMMA presentations meet these criteria. The bi-monthly WNC MMA meetings are eligible for 1 hour of “face-to-face” CE.

For your Reference:

MGMA Guidelines for 50 Hours of Continuing Education (CE) every 3 Years

- ☞ **30 of the 50 hours** must come from MGMA national, state or local
 - Article assessments (free, 10/year offered-*need copy of post-test on file*)
 - Webinars (most are free, 25-45/year offered-*need copy of post-test on file*)
 - Survey participation
 - **12 of these 30 hours** must be face-to-face or “live” learning (*need verification of attendance on file*)
 - Live webinars
 - Live teleconference
 - **Face-to-face events**
 - **National and State conferences**
 - **Local chapter meetings**
